



# Are you visiting today? **WELCOME!**

We are so grateful you have chosen to worship with us today. We hope to get to know you better! Congratulations on finding the Sanctuary! With 2 buildings and a second-floor sanctuary it can be a little tricky! At the bottom of the stairs is a welcome table on which we've placed a free gift (WCCPC mug) for you, along with some information about White Clay. Please stop by before you leave!

**Children are welcome in all of our services.** You are also free to make use of our **nursery** ministry for infants through age 3. At the 8:30 service attendants are on call. Contact an usher if you need child care. For the 11:00 service attendants are present in the nursery, which is located on the first floor of the Nurture Building (room106/107).

At the 11:00 a.m. service, you may prefer that your 4 yr. old through second grade child to go to **Children's Church** rather than have them sit with you during the sermon. A leader meets the children in the back of the sanctuary when announced, and walks them to the Nurture Building. You can pick up your child when the service is over (first floor of Nurture Building, room104).

**Prayer requests** are taken orally and/or in writing at the first service (8:30 traditional). In the contemporary service (11:00), you may put a request in writing. Please use the prayer request forms found in the pew for written requests, placing them in the offering plate. If you know of a **practical need** that the Church can help to meet, whether for yourself or someone else, indicate that in the section marked practical need. Please remember to sign your name. If you would like to have a family member put on the **prayer list** in the bulletin please contact the church office by Wednesday 2:00pm. To put someone on the **prayer chain**, contact the church office.

*Whether you are new to White Clay or have been attending since birth, here are some things to keep in mind:*

Please refrain from bringing food and drink into the sanctuary.

Please silence your cell phone.

**HEARING ASSISTANCE:** If you would like a hearing-assistance receiver assigned to you for use in the worship services, contact Gene Dufaj or see one of our ushers.
