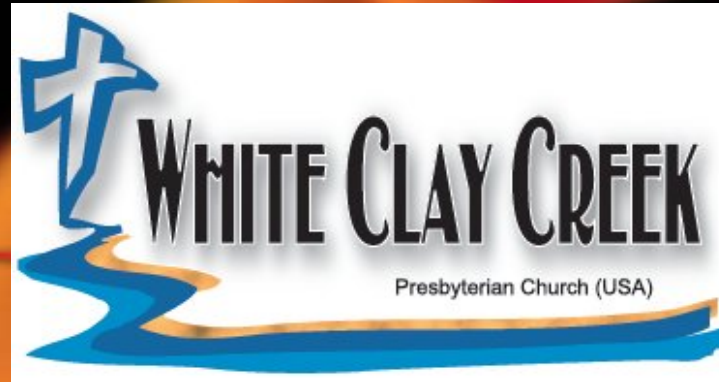

Oil for Anointing – Why do we anoint?

Consecration – Setting apart for the purposes of God

God asked Moses to anoint the tabernacle and its furnishings
“That they be made holy.”

WE are the temple of God. We pray to be consecrated unto the Lord.

Oil for Anointing – Why do we anoint?

Preparation – A preparedness to walk in the purposes of God.

As Mary poured the perfume over Jesus' head to anoint him for his purpose of death and burial, so we can prepare ourselves for the purposes of God

Emancipation – Praying for freedom from
sin, sickness and disease

Call the elders of the church
and let them pray over you and
anoint you with oil in the name
of the Lord

Impartation – Asking God for his power to come into your heart or the heart of a loved one.

Samuel anointed King David, imparting the power of the Spirit “the Spirit of the Lord was upon David from that time.
